




Working Principle

The humane mouse trap works by luring mice with bait and using a one-way door mechanism to trap them inside. The trap is designed to be safe and humane, as it does not harm the mouse in any way. Once caught, the mouse can be safely released into the wild, away from human and animal contact. This method provides an efficient and eco-friendly solution for mouse control while also ensuring the safety and welfare of the animals.



How to Set up



1. Push the top out and pull up the door next to the bait slot;
2. Put the bait inside, such as peanut butter or any other foods rodents are interested in;
3. Set the pedal, and then install the bait door back;
4. Open the entry door and place the trap where the rodent is active;
5. After the rodent goes inside, it will trigger the pedal to close the entry door. Air holes around the trap will keep the rodent from suffocation.
6. Check the trap frequently as the mouse maybe dehydrate to death if left in the trap for a few days;
7. Once capture a rodent, open the bait station and release it.

Warm Tips

- Wild animals are unpredictable. Even with tasty, accessible bait, your house mouse may forgo the trap for a number of reasons: smell, location, obtaining food from another source, general wariness, etc.
- Patience. If you are truly interested in catching a live one and releasing it, then you must have patience to do so and not expect to catch the mouse overnight, or even within a week or two.
- Removing other food sources that may be distracting your mouse by keeping all food in hard plastic/glass/metal or ceramic containers that mice cannot gnaw off, or stored in the fridge.
- Follow through and remember to check your trap regularly. Set reminders on your phone, make sure everyone in the house knows where they are and plan to put eyes on your trap every time you leave and enter your home.
