

Roshield Rat & Mouse Snap Attractant

The syringe allows precise application, making it easy to place the attractant exactly where needed for optimal results. Extensively used in the pest control industry, Roshield's attractant provides a reliable solution for both professionals and homeowners.



Preparation & Placement:



Position the traps in strategic locations such as along walls, near rodent entry points, or in areas where droppings have been found. Apply as suggested below.

Set up the rat or mouse traps in areas with known rodent activity. The attractant is suitable for all environments, including external rodent trap stations.

Application:

Recommended Dosage to place into the bait cup or onto the trigger paddle of each rat trap:

- **Rats:** Dispense 1g of attractant (approximately the size of a pea) (20 traps per syringe).
- **Mice:** Dispense 0.5g of attractant (approximately half the size of a pea) (60 traps per syringe)
- For **trap-shy rodents**, place a small amount of attractant near the entrance of trap boxes (if used) and along nearby rodent runs to increase lure effectiveness.

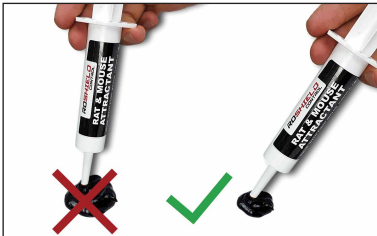
For optimal results, apply the recommended dose directly into the bait well or trigger paddle of each trap.



Monitoring:

- Check the traps regularly and replace the attractant if it dries out or becomes less effective over time.
- Reapply attractant as needed to maintain its potency and effectiveness.

Additional Tips:



Avoid Over-Baiting: Using too much attractant may make the rodents cautious. Stick to the recommended doses for best results.



Use Multiple Traps: For larger infestations, place multiple traps with attractant throughout the area to increase the chances of catching rodents.



Pair with Other Control Methods: For a more comprehensive approach, use the attractant in conjunction with other Roshield rodent solutions for a multi-layered defense.



Regular Inspection: Routinely inspect all traps and bait stations, especially after changes in rodent activity, to ensure ongoing effectiveness.
